

WHAT IS LA TABLÉE DES CHEFS:

La Tablée des Chefs is a non profit organization based in Longueuil (Québec) that has for mission to feed people in need and to develop youths' culinary education through some cooking programs that are adapted according to age, social situation or specific needs.

FEEDING PEOPLE IN NEED:

The Sustainable Food Brokerage Service of La Tablée des Chefs serves as a liaison between food surplus producers, particularly the donors from the HRI (Hotels, Restaurants and Institutions) sector and the organizations that distribute them to people in need. We manage all of the logistics surrounding food recovery to ensure efficient, simple and secure distribution among its participants.

Based on the kind of event where food is to be recovered, we estimate with the donor the amount of containers and labels needed and we ship all needed materials on the site of the event (or elsewhere if requested). We find and book a local community organization to pick up the food the day after the event (or the following Monday if the event takes place on a Friday or during a weekend). Both the donor and the organization that benefits from the food recovery are paired on our web platform and can access their profile and statistics at any time to get informations on the amount of food recovered, event schedules (if the donor becomes recurrent), pickup schedules (date, time, location), material used, etc.

In order to cover the cost of the web platform, the recovery material (containers, bread bags, buckets + shipping and handling), the administrative cost related to the logistics, a fee of 50\$ is charged per pickup. You can chose an event agreement (one invoice per event) an annual agreement (one invoice per year no matter the number of events) or receive an invoice every month (based on estimated number of events). We are not making profits with this service. We need to cover the expenses in order to offer a sustainable and lasting service.
